When: Tuesday, August 5, 2008 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

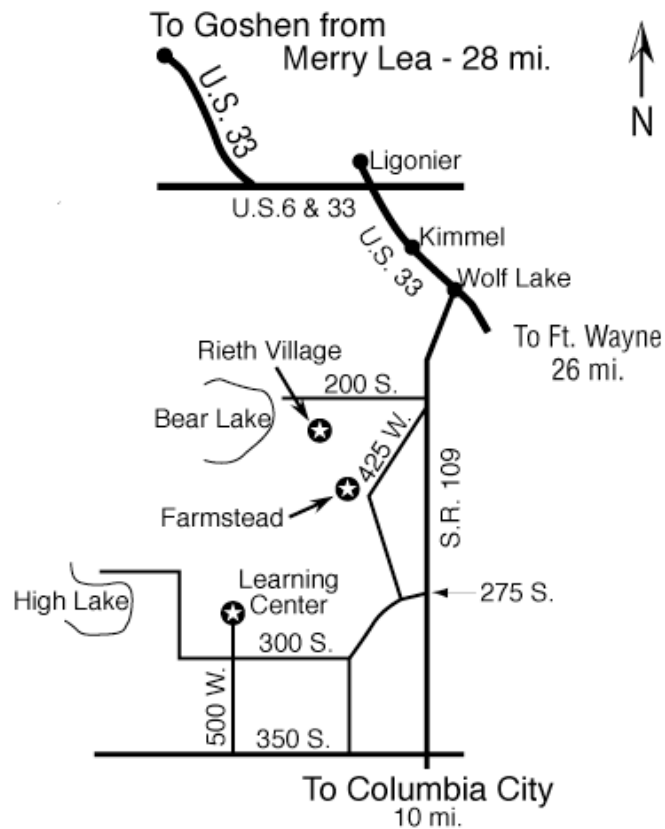

Directions to the Barn at Merry Lea Environmental Learning Center of Goshen College:

From Goshen or Fort Wayne, take U.S. 33 to Wolf Lake. Turn right (south) on S.R. 109. Go 0.7 mile, then turn right onto C.R. 425 W. Turn right into the Farmstead at the first sign marked "General Parking." You may park in the first parking area or go through that parking area and follow the drive to a parking area on the lower side of the barn. Park and follow the walk ways that go to the south end of the barn. Enter to door by the sign "Gathering Room."

From the Columbia City area, take SR 109 north to CR 425W, make a left turn (west on to 425W), and follow the above directions.
